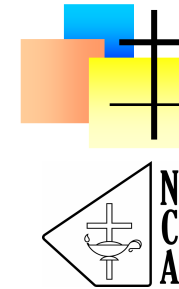

Faculty: All of NCA's 40 teachers and administrators profess a personal relationship with Jesus Christ and have an average of 7.6 years of educational experience. All of our faculty have a bachelor's degree; 16 percent have master's degrees.

Students: The school has a 2007-2008 enrollment of 265 students in grades Pre-K through 12. 61 percent of our students are Nicaraguan, 25 percent are North American, 12 percent are South Korean, and the rest represent 9 other countries in Central America and around the world. Class sizes are limited to 15-20 students, providing for individual attention for each student. 95 percent of our graduates go on to college.

NCA is an evangelical, non-denominational, non-profit preschool, elementary, and secondary educational institution. Founded in 1991, NCA is fully U.S. accredited by the Association of Christian Schools International (ACSI). It is our mission to equip children of Christian parents with the spiritual discernment, the moral courage and the academic excellence to impact society through Christian living motivated by a heartfelt love for God.

Mission

❶ Educate Missionary Kids.

32% of our students are MK's (Missionary Kids). It is our desire that they will gain a cultural understanding of their host country and a passion for mission work, in Nicaragua and around the world. Without the educational opportunities offered by NCA, it would be difficult or impossible for many of the missionaries to carry out the full-time ministries to which God has called them in Nicaragua.

❷ Train Up Future Leaders.

Nicaragua is in desperate need of moral leadership. For hundreds of years, Nicaragua's leaders have made decisions out of a desire for personal gain and have lacked moral integrity, commitment to social justice, and compassion toward their people, resulting in widespread poverty and corruption. 61% of NCA students are Nicaraguan and will be future leaders in their country. Our vision is to give them hope and a resolution to make a difference in their country. Until our leaders are committed to servant leadership based on God's word, the economic situation of the poor in Nicaragua will not improve.

Requirements
